Interim Statement on the accident involving a Tampico TB-9 aircraft with nationality and registration marks 5N-CBJ operated by the Nigerian College of Aviation Technology (NCAT), Zaria which occurred at Zaria Aerodrome, Zaria Kaduna State on 26 September, 2018.

On 26th September 2018 at 0932 h, a Tampico TB9 aircraft with registration and nationality marks 5N-CBJ operated by Nigerian College of Aviation Technology (NCAT), Zaria on a training flight, veered off to the left, exiting runway 23 into the grass area following the loss of directional control of the aircraft after touch-down.

The student-pilot, being the only person on board the aircraft was on the first circuit of what would have been a five Touch and Go 180° Glide maneuver. The student-pilot exited the aircraft un-injured.

ACTION

The draft final report has been completed and sent out to stakeholders for their review and comments within 60 days, in line with the requirements of chapter 6.3 of the Annex 13 to the Convention on International Civil Aviation. The issues raised by the stakeholders will be addressed and the Final Report be made public soon.

This interim report is being issued on the 1st anniversary of the accident in accordance with the provisions of ICAO Annex 13.

In accordance with Annex 13 to the Convention on International Civil Aviation, Civil Aviation Act 2006, Civil Aviation (Investigation of Air Accident and Incidents) Regulations 2019, the sole purpose of this Investigation is to prevent Aviation accidents and serious incidents. It is not the purpose of any such investigation and the associated Investigation report to apportion blame or liability.
